Classes: \$25 each

Each class will run with schooling phase first, followed by a critique session from the judge. The same group of riders will then RERIDE the class, being judged. Ribbons awarded for judged portion.

Informal clothing accepted: Boots, helmet, riding pants, solid color/collared shirt, please. Dress for the weather!

Classes will run in this order:

Division A: Walk Trot Only

1. Equitation

2. Pleasure

Division B: Beginner Equitation

3. Walk Trot Canter (Canter may be individual)

4. Ground Pole Pattern

Division C: Maiden/Novice Equitation

5. Walk Trot Canter

6. Crossrails

Division D: Pleasure: horses may be asked to extend, or back

9. Open Pleasure

10. Open Pleasure

Division E: Green Horse/Rider Hunter

7. Under Saddle

8. Over Fences 2'

Terms to Know:

Equitation: Judging rider's position and horse's response to the rider's aids.

Pleasure: Judging the horse's attitude, manners and suitability; which horses seem the most pleasurable to ride.

Hunters: Judging the horse's manners, suitability and performance; which horses seem most reliable to take riding outside of the ring.
